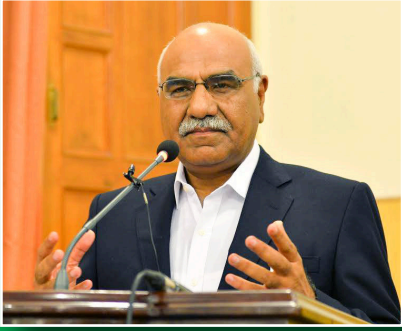

I have done my masters in Organic Chemistry from University of Karachi. Currently I am a student of M.Phil leading to PhD at ICCBS, University of Karachi. My research field is Computational Medicinal Chemistry, which is about investigating materials that are difficult to find or expensive to purchase. It also helps

chemists make predictions before running the actual experiments so that they can be better prepared for making observations.

I have worked on different research projects. One of my collaborative work as co-author is recently published in an International Journal Scientific Reports - Nature entitled "Purification and Characterization of a Nonspecific Lipid Transfer Protein 1 (nsLTP1) from Aijwain (Trachyspermum ammi) Seeds". The plant nsLTPs are well-known for their antibacterial, and anti-cancer activities. This study revealed that aijwain non-specific lipid transfer protein has possible application in drug delivery application.

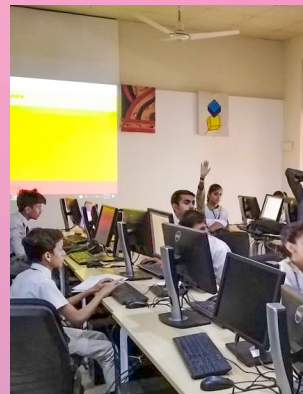

Continuing Education Program

The CEP Continuing Education Program 2019 is an integral part of our NJV school improvement plan. In this age of rapid technology intervention, we need to equip and prepare our students for the challenges ahead.

This on-going program is conducted every Saturday from 9am to 12pm. It is structured in three months (12 classes) blocks.

The vision of this program is to introduce various talents and skills in a highly structured plan. The students pick a topic of their choice from the courses offered. They follow an intense program for the entire block learning from seasoned masters in their field and explore new potential career paths.

The courses offered are various disciplines of Art. As art is considered to be the leading medium of instruction, helping to translate thought and ideas into tangible real life solutions. It also helps in dealing with emotional problems. Computer Scratch, Web and Graphic design are the future of freelance career paths of today. While Sports teach them competitive skills, how to deal with success and failures and how to be team players. Proficiency in English opens the knowledge base of the world to them. Cooking polishes their culinary skills; this could also be a career choice. Gardening teaches them how to respect and take care of the fine eco system by planting and caring, and inculcate good eating habits by maintaining their organic edible garden.

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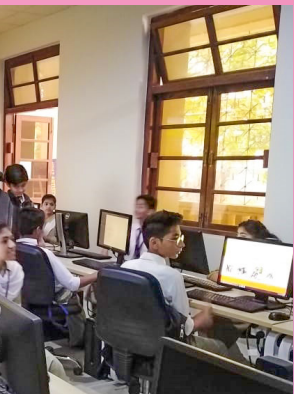

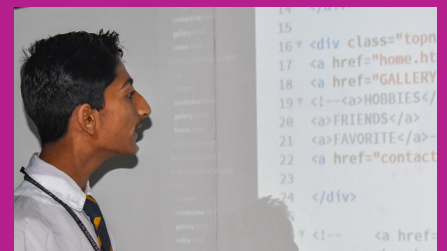

In a busy “progressive” world, where all of us want to grow, we often forget the suppressed voices of the people living below the poverty line in slums of rural areas. Living in developed urban cities is a privilege to some of us, but a wish for many living in slums of rural Sindh. According to the new poverty index, 4 out of 10 Pakistanis live in multidimensional poverty where people experience deprivations with respect to health, education and standard of living.

Ashok Kumar hails from one such village in Tando Bago, Badin. His family, belongs to the agriculture and livestock sector, barely meets ends in provision of food; let alone other amenities. We applaud Ashok’s father who envisioned sending Ashok to our school, where everything will be

provided to him for free: food, uniform, books, formal classroom education and informal education like arts, sports and cooking. It was saddening to know that just to bring Ashok to Karachi, he had to sell his goat to cover the expenses.

His father proudly explained that he wants Ashok to be the Principal of a school in Tando Bago so that he can serve his community.



Ashok, along with 61 other students, is currently living in our hostel. NJV is the only Government School providing a free Hostel facility with the support of Sindh Education Foundation (SEF) and Sindh Education and Literacy Department (SELD). You can be part of our journey in providing free quality education to more youngsters from rural Sindh!

Pakistan Day Sports Festival 2019

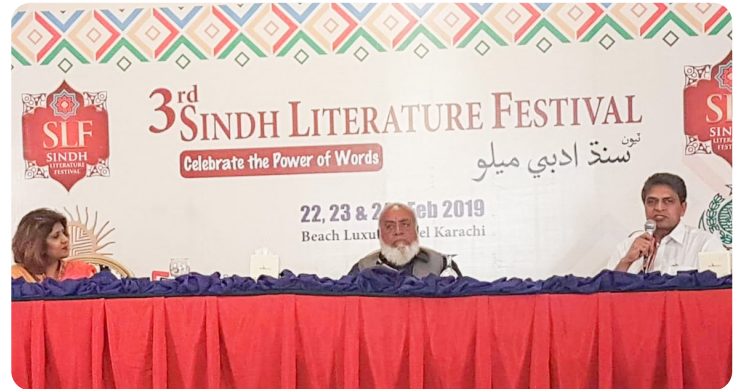
