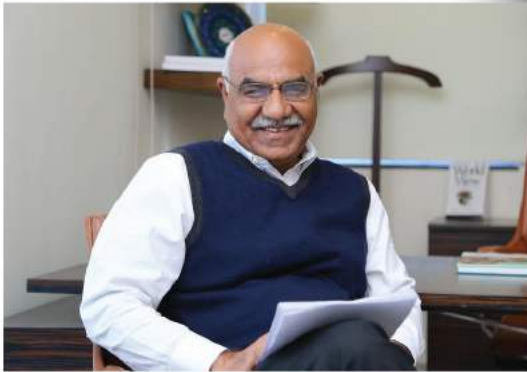
GEMMA – Mural Art Contest participation

Gardening

The practice of growing and cultivating plants. Students planted and watered trees and learnt about different types of soil and the importance of manure. Furthermore, they learnt about the process of photosynthesis.

Treasure Hunt

Hunts allow kids to practice problem-solving in a tangible way. Students were grouped in four and given clues to find and complete their respective puzzles.

Basic First Aid Training

First Aid saves lives. Students learnt how to check blood pressure and glucose level using digital meters. They learnt about different types of bleeding and how to control minor bleeding using bandages. Students taught how to talk to a doctor.

Cooking
