


6th HOSTEL BATCH ADMISSION TEST


STUDENTS FARWELL




In the Fine Arts courses, students can explore various artistic techniques and mediums, developing their drawing, painting, and visual arts skills.




CERAMICS



Eligibility to Apply

- 1st division in intermediate and matriculation exams or equivalent
- Intermediate or equivalent with mathematics is mandatory for BS-IT
- The applicant must appear in the NAT test or Akhuwat College entry test administered by NTS
- Intermediate result-awaiting candidates may also apply but they must submit the results before the final selection
- The monthly household income of the candidate must not exceed Rs. 70,000/-
- The short-listed candidates will be called for Interview
