It is a tribute to his inspiring belief that human goodness and solidarity will find ways to eradicate poverty, and his determination to stay with a mission that has already helped millions of Pakistani families.

Akhuwat is the largest microfinance institution in Pakistan, offering a package of loans for the poor. It has distributed 4.8 million interest free loans amounting to the equivalent of USD 900 million, helping three million families, with a

remarkable 99.9% loan repayment rate.



Education is being revolutionized globally through integration of technology and digital resources. The need for online education increased when the COVID-19 pandemic hit and normal activities came to a halt. Arguably, education is the most effected sector.

Where many institutes fell behind in adopting an innovative approach to education, NJV School stepped up with its eLearning project. From providing tablets to the students in need, to developing a state-of-the-art elearning studio setup, NJV School's management and academics team set an example of quality education through online means.



We are proud of our teachers who adopted the new methodology with high spirits and continued the flow of education with zeal. Taking this project forward, NJV School aims to use this method to educate multiple students at remote locations where educational resources are scarce.







As part of its 360-degree student development model, NJV sent a group of grade-XII students to the northern areas of Pakistan. This all-Pakistan Educational Tour gave participants a chance to see and get to learn about diverse places and cultures across the country. The students were also taught how to work as a team while learning leadership and discipline in preparation to become future leaders of Pakistan.

The journey started on 22nd September 2021 from Karachi. The group of 80 people – including students and mentors – took a flight from Jinnah International Airport to Lahore. For most students air travel was a new learning experience.

Lahore, known as the city of gardens, is home to Akhuwat's Head Office; over the years many social interventions have been undertaken by Akhuwat in Lahore and its surroundings. During their four-day stay in Lahore, the group visited the Akhuwat Head Office, Fountain House, Minar-e-Pakistan, Badshahi Mosque, Red Fort, Havel Restaurant, the Walled City, and Akhuwat Learning Hub School. A full day trip to Akhuwat College Kasur was taken to witness inauguration of the Hospitality Management Institute, including a motivational session by Akhuwat Founder Dr. Amjad Saqib.

The group then visited Akhuwat's Faisalabad Institute of Research, Science and Technology (Akhuwat FIRST), Akhuwat Women's College Chakwal, and then headed for the mesmerizing valleys of Azad Kashmir.

For the next four days, the group travelled across Muzaffarabad, with stopovers at Pateka, Keran, and Sharda. They also trekked through the upper Neelum Valley and visited Kutton Waterfalls. This was quite a memorable and enjoyable time as, with no phones or internet, the students and their mentors were solely engaged in experiencing the beauty of Mother Nature.

The students also got a chance to visit the Pak Austria Fachhochschule, Institute of Applied Sciences and Technology, in Haripur. The detailed tour of the facility was quite a learning experience.

The group had a lunch stopover at Murree, then proceeded to Islamabad. As it was now 3rd October – the third anniversary of batch one hostel students – a celebration was held with cakes and pizzas; the cold rain in Islamabad added a flavor of itself.

In Islamabad, the group toured the Islamic International University, the National Assembly, Central University of Science and Technology, Rawalpindi's Raja Bazar, Ghulam Ishaq Khan University, and the Institute of Regional Studies. During the visit to Islamabad Club, students got a chance to interact with and be mentored by high-ranking government officials, a truly inspiring experience. While meeting the Foreign Secretary, Mr. Sohail Mehmood at the Foreign Secretariat, the group was paid a surprise visit by Shah Mehmood Qureshi, the Foreign Minister of Pakistan.

The group departed from Islamabad on 7th October 2021 via Greenline Business train; again, a new experience for most students. Arrival in Karachi was on the 8th of October, replete with long-lasting memories, gratitude, improved social sense, and plans to change the world!


