NJVSMB is a not for profit organization working in the public education development sector to provide quality education to the deserving students in Pakistan to bring positive socioeconomic impact in the country by nurturing future leaders and inculcating strong knowledge base, critical thinking skills, hands on skills in arts and emerging technologies, and strong ethics social responsibility in our students.

Our motto, "Knowledge is coupled with deed" lays the foundation of our philosophy for the development of public education sector and bring it at par with the global standards of human resource development and utilization.

Over 13,000 students in 16 different locations in Sindh and Balochistan benefit from the organization's initiatives and receive free education and relevant supplies, mentorship and guidance, and skills development opportunities.

Our organization works closely with Akhuwat, world's largest interest free microfinancing organization, working towards alleviation of poverty by providing entrepreneurship and education opportunities.













The journey of Akhuwat started in 2001 by Dr. Muhammad Amjad Saqib with the philosophy of Mawakhat preached by our beloved Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) in which he urged the Ansars (citizens of Madina) to share their belonging and support with the Muhajirs (migrants).

Through this model, Akhuwat started providing interest-free microfinance to underprivileged people for small scale businesses and help generate economic returns for themselves. Since then, Akhuwat has **disbursed PKR 233 billion** in revolving credit which has **benefited over 5.4 million** households all over Pakistan. For his philanthropic efforts, Dr. Muhammad Amjad Saqib has received multiple awards and appreciations including the honorable **Ramon Magsaysay award in 2022.** 

With the same philosophy, Akhuwat provides services in the public sector education through adoption of more than 300 schools and establishment of 3 colleges which have over **47,000** students to date.




#### **UNIVERSITY ADMISSIONS**










## QUALIFIED FACULTY AND AFTER SCHOOL SUPPORT

To address the shortage of quality teachers in the public sector, NJV School hired qualified professionals to improve education quality. Teachers provide personalized attention to ensure students grasp concepts and can apply their knowledge. After-school support programs are available for students needing additional help, offering individual guidance from experienced educators.



**Teachers on NJVSMB Payroll** 



## **KG ADMISSIONS**



NJVSMB adheres to a strict merit-based admissions policy, aiming to select deserving students for optimal outcomes. Starting December 2023, it opened KG admissions through an entrance test for children under 5 from households earning less than **Rs. 45,000**.



## **BREAKFAST PROGRAM**

An in-house survey revealed that **60%-70%** of students attend school without proper breakfast, contributing to malnutrition and underperformance. In response, NJVSMB initiated a program to provide nutritious breakfast, fruits during recess, and afternoon lunch to students.







## COUNSELING FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS

Focusing on the mental wellbeing of the students along with highlighting the learning disabilities and assisting the students in their education according to their learning style, the Student Affairs department at NJV School keeps a continuous process of training, identification, prevention and therapy for students and parents to provide a safe space for students' wellbeing.

Special learning programs are introduced for students with learning disabilities in consultation with our qualified team of psychologists and educationists.

## STATION LEARNING AND PROJECT BASED PEDAGOGY

In consultation with TRC and employed educationists, NJV School started training teachers and planning to take then teaching methodologies to the next level. NJV School will have 11:1 student to teacher ratio in the Primary section from 2023-24 and introduce project based learning methodologies in the middle and secondary sections.



# CONTINUING ENRICHMENT PROGRAM (CEP)


The CEP Programs operate year-round, providing students with a wide range of skill development courses, including Fine Arts, Ceramics, Photography, Music, Graphic Design, Theatre, Product Design, Chess, Archery, Cooking, Programming, and Robotics. At the conclusion of each course, students present their final projects to a panel of jury members, comprised of industry professionals. The jury selects the top-performing students in each course, who are then awarded appreciation certificates and given the opportunity to participate in industry visits.



### **HOSTEL PROGRAM**

Since 2018, NJV School Management has partnered with the Sindh Education Foundation (SEF) to provide a hostel program for 100 students annually from Sindh (excluding Karachi), offering 4-year scholarships from Grade 8 to 12, along with various support services. The program's success is highlighted by the increase in applications, with 6,000 in 2023 and over 8,253 in 2024. This year, 110 deserving students were selected through a comprehensive interview process that assesses family, academic, psychological, and medical backgrounds. The selection was conducted by over 250 volunteers from NJV School, ensuring merit and quality.


#### APPLICANTS FROM EACH DISTRICT












## **E-LEARNING PROJECT**

The NJVSMB is dedicated to providing quality education in Pakistan by creating a centralized platform for digital resources. Their e-Learning Department has developed a Learning Management System (LMS) for teachers, enhancing classroom engagement through simulations. gamified learning, and interactive workbooks. Since January 2022, they have connected six schools in rural areas to their e-Learning project, serving nearly 700+ students daily with live online classes from qualified teachers in Karachi. Positive results include improved attendance, comprehension in English, math skills, and scientific understanding. NJV aims to partner with the Government of Sindh to expand to 50 schools, reaching around 700+ students per shift, providing quality education to underserved areas and fostering positive societal contributions.

## ASP FOR SCIENCE AND TECH PROJECTS

#### **ADVANCED MACHINING & PROTOTYPING**

Students will learn to operate CNC machines, understand machining tools, and apply precision measurement. The curriculum emphasizes hands-on projects, where students design and fabricate prototypes, enhancing their problem-solving skills and fostering creativity in engineering design.

#### **INTRODUCTION TO HYDROPONICS**

Students explore the innovative world of hydroponics, a method of growing plants without soil. Participants will learn about different hydroponic systems, nutrient management, and plant biology. The hands-on experience will include setting up and maintaining hydroponic systems.

#### INTRODUCTION TO EV TECHNOLOGY

Focusing on the burgeoning field of electric vehicles (EVs), this course covers the fundamentals of EV technology, including battery systems, electric drivetrains, and charging infrastructure. Students will engage in discussions about the environmental impacts of EVs and explore the latest innovations in sustainable transportation.

Through this collaboration, students gain practical knowledge and hands-on experience, preparing them for opportunities in cybersecurity and other related professions.

#### JUNAID MUGHERI WINS BRONZE MEDAL




